

Financial Aid 2011-12

Over the past several years CARDEN ARBOR VIEW SCHOOL has been in the fortunate position to provide financial aid to families that have needed assistance with tuition. As you can probably imagine, the need increased substantially in 2008 and we have gone from serving 7% of our population to 23%. With this increase in need came a decrease in available funds and a lowering of the maximum awards we were able to give. We are at the time of year when we need to begin the preliminary school budgeting process and it is important for us to have an idea of the financial aid needs for the 2011-12 academic year. Families currently receiving financial aid who believe they will continue to need assistance should begin the application process again so that we can confirm their qualification status. Families that have not previously received financial aid and may have had a change in financial status should begin the process now by going to sss.nais.org/parents. **Our school code is 1393**. This is where you will set up an account and enter your information. SSS determines need and notifies CAVS; however, award amounts are at the discretion of the Board of Trustees and are based upon available funds. Tax returns are required for verification of financial data and will be due to SSS by June. If you have any questions, or need a hard copy of the application, please contact Mrs. Johnson.
