


Dear 6th Grade Student,

Over the summer you will have two requirements to complete for your 6<sup>th</sup> grade World History class.

#### Part 1 - READING

- Read The Egypt Game by Zilpha Keatly Snyder, a Newbury Award recipient.
  - One theme of World History is culture and social behavior of a civilization. While reading the book, pay attention to the ancient Egyptian cultural details included in the Egypt game the kids play.
  - You can find this book through multiple online sources such as Amazon and Barnes and Noble.
  - There will be classwork assignments to complete upon returning to school.
  - Bring your book to the first class.

- Do not read information off of the slide



What is manufactured in your town? What is exported? Imported?

Do most people work in your town or do they commute elsewhere?

### 5. **HUMAN/ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION**

How have people DEPENDED on the environment?

How have people ADAPTED to the environment?

How have people MODIFIED the environment?

What local resources do people depend on?

### 6. PHOTOGRAPHS

Find old and new photographs or maps of your town that show you how the environment has changed over time.
