

THIRD GRADE SUMMER ASSIGNMENT

In an effort to encourage children to read simply for pleasure, as well as to encourage them to stay up with their cursive and mathematics facts, the summer assignment will focus on these things in a new way:

In a composition notebook (wide ruled), each student will create a summer journal.

Here are the requirements:

1. Student makes 2 entries each week (at least 5-7 sentences each). Date each entry
2. Student must make each entry in cursive (If they are struggling, printing is fine but please encourage to try!)
3. Practice Multiplication facts at least 1-2 times per week. Students should be proficient through 6 tables.

TOPICS ON WHICH TO JOURNAL

- Enjoy a magazine or travel pamphlet from a vacation and tell me about what you read
- Reading a fun book. Tell me about a chapter.
- Summer is a time for fun adventures and lazy days. Write about those days on occasion.
- Did you go on a vacation or make a new friend?
- Turn multiplication problems into division problems
- Write a story from your imagination.
