3. Student chooses from the variety of topics below and must write at least 5 sentences (when it is not a math entry)

### **TOPICS ON WHICH TO JOURNAL**

- Enjoy a magazine or travel pamphlet from a vacation and tell me about what you read
- Reading a fun book? Tell me about a chapter.
- Summer is a time for fun adventures and lazy days. Write about those days on occasion.
- Did you go on a vacation or make a new friend?
- Simply practice your cursive alphabet, upper-case and lower-case
- Build your multiplication tables, 0–12
- Turn multiplication problems into division problems
- Write a story from your imagination
